- 10. Where do I see the growth of my website in 6 months?

This section is one of the main reasons why you need to plan before you make a website. There are so many people who have created a website before planning and about 2 months after creating the website, they want to start uploading videos, but unfortunately their current web host doesn't have that feature.

This is another reason why I **DON'T** recommend using a free web host.

So that's why I have you plan before you make a website and visualize not only the beginning process of website creation, but the possible features you may want to add to your website 3, 6 or even a year from now.

#### What's Your Niche?

What's a niche? Quite simply a niche is like a focused category. Your niche should be a passion or an area of expertise. The more narrow and focused your niche is, the better it will be for people to find you through the search engines.

Once you know your niche, you'll be able to determine what your keywords are. Keywords play a very important part in being found by searchers and ranking high on the search engines.

Whatever niche you choose should be something you enjoy! Don't make it a bore, especially when it doesn't have to be.

Think about it for a minute.... the people you see on T.V. Are those doing what they love to do and making a living by doing just that.

So, find that thing you love and build a website around that! Ultimately the choice is yours, so choose anything that your comfortable with and that will work for you.

#### **Choose A Domain Name**



Now it's time to choose the right domain name for your website.

Do you know what your main keywords are? You'll want to use them in your domain name.

Your domain name can be 63 characters long, and include letters, numbers and hyphens. Even though you get to use 63 characters, don't. You want your domain name to be easy enough for your visitors to remember right?

Shoot for a .com extension, and this is only because it's the most popular and most memorable for website visitors, however, there are other options. I'll leave that up to you.

Your domain name should be a short description of whatever your website is going to be about.

I always recommend writing down at least 15 different domain name possibilities just in case one is taken. One of the great things about making a website with Homestead is that if the domain name you've chosen is taken, they'll give you a list of other options that you can choose from.

After you've chosen your domain names, you can now register your domain name and begin making a website.
